Happy New Year and Happy 60th Anniversary to TBS!

Re-enrollment begins January 15. The TBS Board of Directors (BOD) is pleased to announce that tuition will remain the same for all grades for a second consecutive year. There will be a modest increase in Student Services, Athletics and Transportation Fees. See our website for more details.

Our goal remains keeping high quality, private Christian education affordable. We are committed to our discount programs for ministers and missionaries, military service members, multi-child families, single parents, faculty/staff tuition remission, and need based financial aid for qualifying families.
