

Dear parents and guardians,

Happy Summer! We hope that you and your family have been enjoying some down time and the great outdoors so far, but believe it or not, the start of school is just around the corner! One of our most exciting events of the semester – our annual High School Retreat – will be here before you know it!

This year, the annual high school retreat will once again be held from **August 30th – September 1st, 2023, at Black Diamond Adventure Camp in Auburn, Washington.** The cost for transportation, lodging, and meals has been covered by your tuition payment.

The **Parental/Guardian Consent Form & Liability Waiver**, which is needed in order to attend the retreat, is attached. **Please return by Monday, August 28**th. Students who do not turn in a permission slip will not be allowed to go on the retreat. If your student will be required to take any medications (both prescription or over the counter) while on the retreat, you and your health provider must complete and return to the office a Physician 's Medication Order Form along with the prescribed medication in its original container. This medication form must be turned in to the office by a parent, not a student.
